## YOU NAME IT

Mother of Life Pregnancy Center has a lovely variety of memorialization opportunities available in our chapel and at the entrance to our building.



On both sides of our front door there are elevated terraces comprised entirely of memorial bricks, some of which are blank. Each is 8" wide by 3.75" tall. Messages of dedication can be up to three lines at 18 characters and spaces per line. With your donation of \$100 we will have the brick engraved and installed with your message.

In Our Lady of Guadalupe Chapel, several holy devotionals are available for dedication, including the 14th Station of the Cross (\$40), the lectern (\$150), and nine pews (\$300 each).
